COMPETITION ATTIRE (Coaches & Spotters)

Coaches and spotters must dress appropriately:

- CLUB t-shirt/polo shirt
- CLUB track jacket (with or without track pants)
 - o Pants must be ¾ or full length
- No hats, shorts, midriff tops, ripped or torn clothing or similar will NOT be accepted
- Appropriate indoor sport footwear (sneakers/runners no flip flops)

COMPETITION ATTIRE (Athletes)

Dress for Competitors

All athletes must dress in their <u>CURRENT</u> club's team competitive attire for all preliminaries at GymBC sanctioned events unless prior approval of the TGTC is given. Any/all athletes not dressed in their <u>CURRENT</u> club's team competitive attire <u>will receive a dress code violation</u> per the Canadian Competition regulations routine/pass.

GymCan Canadian Competition Rules:

Women:

Competition leotard with or without sleeves Unitard could be mid-thigh length

Gym shorts may be worn (must be part of the uniform)

- Must not be longer than mid-thigh
- Must be skin-tight
- The shorts can either be the same colour as the leotard or black (should coordinate with the leotard)
- Athletes who choose to wear shorts from the same CLUB must all have the same brand
- No obvious logos
- Club athletes can either choose to wear shorts or no shorts (not all the athletes of the same club are required to choose the same for Individual Competition)

<u>SYNCHRO</u> - the pair MUST match and either choose to both wear shorts or not wear shorts Long tights or full-length one-piece leotard will be accepted.

Men:

Sleeveless or short sleeve singlet.

Competition Longs OR gym shorts in a single colour Exception: black or any other deep dark colour Length of shorts must not be longer than MID-thigh.

Footwear:

Mandatory for TRA and DMT. TUM may compete barefoot.

TG Women: White trampoline shoes and/or white foot covering.

TG Men: White trampoline shoes and/or foot covering of the same colour as the competition longs

Jewellery:

No jewellery may be worn by competitors, spotters and/or coaches as spotters. Taping of jewellery is NOT adequate.

Medic alert bracelets can be worn but must be taped.

Medical support braces can be white or beige in colour.

Warm-up:

When warm-up is conducted in the competition gym, all competitors and coaches must dress in proper club competition attire or equivalent.

INCLUSIVITY:

All GymCan rules apply for proper attire for specific and general warm-up and competitions. Athletes can wear either male or female CLUB uniform.

NOTE: National Team competition attire is reserved only to athletes that are currently or have been a member of a Canadian Team (World Championships, World Age Group Competitions and/or international competitions)

TEAM BC SELECTION 2025 Western Canada Cup

2025 Western Canda Cup

Athletes wishing to attend the Western Canada Cup as Team BC athletes must:

- Be registered and in good standing with GymBC
- Provincial Level 3 and/or Level 4 athletes must compete at a minimum of one (1) BC Provincial Cup AND BC Championships
- Meet the TGTC minimum qualifying standard ONCE per discipline
- Must be registered with the host organizing committee within the set deadline and in the appropriate categories
- The athletes' best qualifying score from two (2) eligible BC Provincial Cup AND/OR BC Championships shall be totaled, and shall count towards team selection
- Athletes, women and men combined, will be ranked in descending order
